The President's Scholarship, which ranges from \$15,000 to \$17,000 per year, represents Gustavus Adolphus College's financial commitment to academic excellence. Through an application and interview process, candidates will be reviewed for their previous accomplishments and potential for future success. Past recipients of these highly selective awards enrolled in the most academically challenging courses offered, ranked near the top of their graduating class, and earned at least a composite score of 30 on the ACT or 1320 on the SAT. **Submission of test scores and this application is required. Qualified candidates may be invited to participate in a scholarship competition at Gustavus on February 27 or March 6, 2010.** Awards are renewable with a 3.25 cumulative grade point average.
