MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

- President’s Scholarship:** Awards ranging from \$15,000–\$17,000 annually represent the College’s financial commitment to academic excellence. Past recipients of these highly selective awards enrolled in the most academically challenging courses offered, ranked near the top of their graduating class, and earned a composite score of at least 30 on the ACT or 1320 on the SAT.
- Music Scholarship:** Jussi Björling Music Scholarships, ranging from \$2,000–\$6,000 annually, support students continuing their participation in music at Gustavus. Although scholarships are available to students of any major, all winners are required to participate in a performing ensemble.
- Theatre and Dance Scholarship:** Evelyn Anderson Theatre and Dance Scholarships, ranging from \$500–\$2,000 annually, are awarded to candidates who have demonstrated talent and commitment to pursuing theatre and/or dance regardless of their intended major.
- Art Scholarship:** Awards ranging from \$500–\$2,000 annually recognize students who have demonstrated talent and commitment to studying the visual arts regardless of their intended major.
- Speech Scholarship:** Gustavus’s \$1,000–\$2,000 National Forensic League Scholarship is awarded annually to candidates who demonstrate talent and commitment in individual forensics events competition.
